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# Mercy Housing and Human Development



- ✘ We were founded in 1997, is a nonprofit organization based in Gulfport Mississippi. Our mission is to develop strategies to provide housing, community and economic development in the coastal counties of Mississippi. Through research/analysis, advocacy, direct services and community organizing, MHHD responds to community needs.
- ✘ Homeownership preparation, financial literacy and counseling, foreclosure prevention and a variety of educational programs are offered to low wealth and minority South Mississippians. MHHD also offers free tax preparation, post purchase support, matched savings programs, and has a certified Affordable Care Act Navigator on staff.
- ✘ MHHD has historically advocated for vulnerable groups. Following the BP oil spill, we provided language assistance through interpretation and translation of materials and case management for the Vietnamese American population to receive emergency assistance. Efforts have also been focused on addressing the inequitable policies in the post disaster response and recovery.
- ✘ At Mercy Housing and Human Development we believe that all people have basic rights to dignity and compassion.
- ✘ Further, we believe that people, as social beings, achieve their individual rights and dignity in relationship to others in the larger community.

  - a. **Outreach & Education:** MHHD serving county with Vietnamese community very spread out. Education and outreach has been a challenge, currently reaching about 10-30 people at a time. Would like assistance to develop better outreach strategies. Outreach opportunities:
    - i. Churches
    - ii. Nail salons
    - iii. Harbor Fisher folk
    - iv. Casinos
  - b. **Provider Training** – Hep B Task Force (Amy Trang) CME training planned to bring together providers.
    - i. **FQHC** – Local community health center does not have capacity to treat hepatitis B patients.
      1. Project ECHO is recruiting FQHCs for the HBV project and this could be an opportunity to increase knowledge at local FQHC.
  - c. **Data Collection** – MS Dept. of Health has hired someone to do data analysis. Xuan will find out more and share current HBV screening intake form.
  - d. **Community Advisory Board** convening – advice on other stakeholders to engage. The board meets in person monthly and via conference calls.

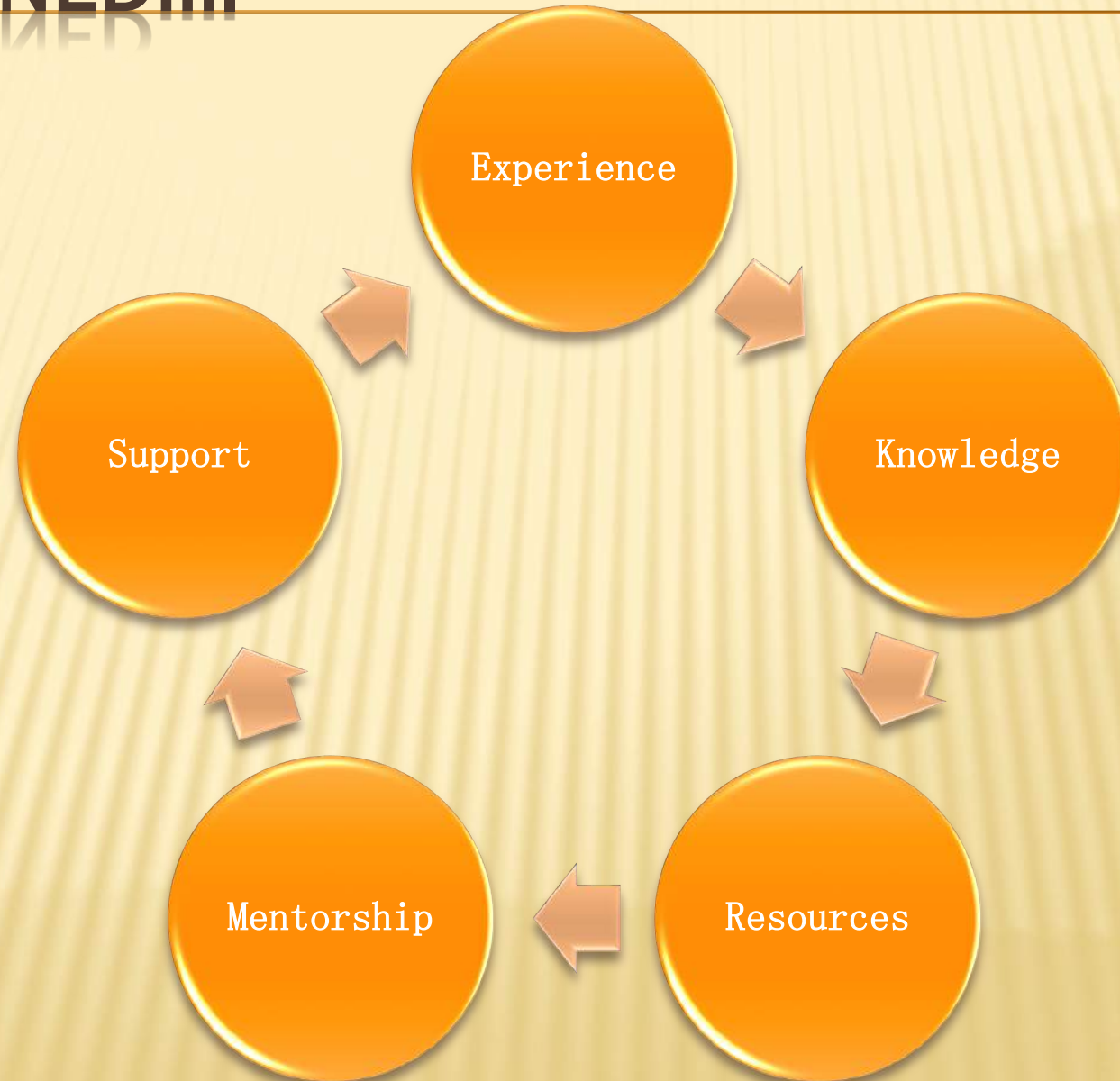
