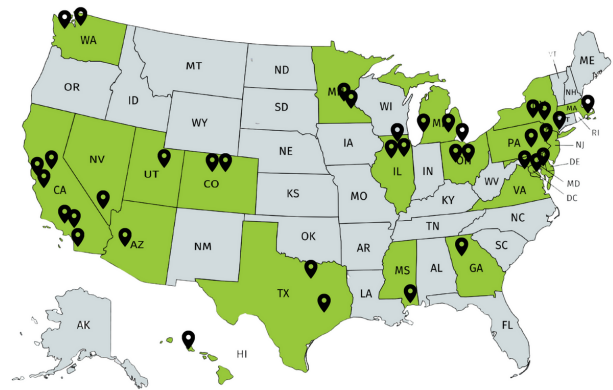


## Implementing Our Mission

### Awareness

### Prevention

Increase hepatitis B testing and vaccination, particularly among Asian Americans, Pacific Islanders and other high-risk communities.

### Intervention

Improve access to care and treatment for individuals living with hepatitis B to prevent end-stage liver disease and liver cancer.



## Our Accomplishments

- Improving access to healthcare services among Asian American and Pacific Islander & other high-risk communities across the United States
- Testing 20,000 people per year for hepatitis B infection
- Providing culturally and linguistically appropriate linkage to care and treatment for those affected
- Advocating for federal funding and policies that increase access to hepatitis B testing, vaccination, and treatment, and address hepatitis B-related stigma and discrimination
